

Fit Test Procedure

Pregnancy and Upper Respiratory Biological Exposure

To prevent exposure to formaldehyde and other potentially infectious materials for those pregnant, lactating, expecting to become pregnant and those with chronic upper respiratory problems, **MUST** follow this procedure in order to participate in the Gross Anatomy Laboratory.

- **Proper PPE MUST be worn at ALL times in the Gross Anatomy Laboratory.**
- Participants who are pregnant, lactating, expecting to become pregnant or becomes pregnant during the gross anatomy course and those with upper respiratory problems should identify themselves **IMMEDIATELY** to the Block Director, Program and or Course Coordinator to be fitted for a respirator.
- Participants will be directed to Health and Emergency Management Services (HEMS) for N95 Training and Fit Testing.
- Upon completion of the Fit Test, a certificate of completion will be filed with the Gross Anatomy Laboratory Manager and participants are cleared to enter the gross anatomy laboratory.
- The respirator should be worn each time the participant is in the gross anatomy laboratory. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
